




N. of bikesharing rentals in Milan, Turin and Bergamo



N. of Station-Based Bikesharing subscribers in Milan, Turin and Bergamo







Annual travel increase Company Carpooling






N. of cities reached by services








Shared mobility services range







Mobility services combination along a route -D2D-





PLATFORM NETWORK









The Italian National Platform Shared Mobility, launched in september 2015, is promoted by the Ministry of Environment, Land and Sea, the Ministry for Infrastructure and Transport and the Sustainable Development Foundation. The Platform is composed by over 90 members, including shared mobility providers, institutions, local authorities and research centers.

The main purpose of the initiative is to create a collaboration platform between public and private institutions, shared mobility services providers, accademia and research institutes in order to analyse, encourage and promote the shared mobility phenomenon in Italy. Each year, the Platform collets data and publishes the National Report, disseminating information and best practices.

The Platform organises every year the National Conference on Shared Mobility, wich represents the occasion to take stock of the trends of shared mobility in Italy and to engage in a public exchange between institutions, local administrations and members of the Platform on perspectives and opportunities of the sector. During the Conference the Report on Shared Mobility in Itlay is presented.


